





In a world that is often characterised by quick answers and superficial impressions, I want to create a counter-movement with my art. I encourage people to pause, take a closer look and engage with their own perception. Ultimately, the beauty and meaning of a work of art lies in the eye of the beholder and my art should help to sharpen and deepen this view.

Born in 1980 in Graz/Austria, I grew up in a family of art lovers. Our house was full of works by Egon Schiele, Vincent van Gogh, Salvador Dalí and many more. I started painting at the age of 7 and for years i tried to copy the masterpieces around me. One of my oldest memories is that I was sitting in a gallery and trying to understand why exactly all the visitors were so fascinated by the water lilies of a certain "Monet".

Even as a teenager, I was enthusiastic about new innovations and tried to expand my creativity with new technologies. After learning graphic design at school, I worked for several years as a designer for various companies. I designed layouts for websites, logos, posters, brochures and much more.

At the age of 23, I turned one of my greatest hobbies into my profession: photography. I spent many years learning from great photographers in various areas of photography. I have travelled around the world and worked as a team photographer for Red Bull Racing in Formula 1 and as the official photographer of the "Life Ball" for "Getty Images".

At the age of 32, I started to create my own projects as an art director. Among other things, I was honoured with awards at Art Basel Miami, at Biennale in Venice and was accepted into the Sony Europe Imaging Ambassador programme. I subsequently had the pleasure of working with famous artists such as Andreas Gursky, Erwin Wurm and Herbert Brandl.


I have learnt a lot from painting. For a long time, I experimented with the rules of pictorial composition and their psychological effect on the viewer. Technologies open up new possibilities for me as an artist. I enjoy incorporating all influences, impressions, experiences and skills into my current work.



Chromatic Canvas I

"Chromatic Canvas I" is the title of my first digital & hand-painted art bottle series in co-operation with the Italian Prosecco brand Desiderio N1. Countless layers of geometric characters, combined with harmonising and contrasting colours, create a three-dimensional composition that speaks directly to our subconscious and is intended to convey joie de vivre and lightness.

With the help of a digital drawing pad and a pressure-intensive pen, I built up this basic design on more than 15 layers and drew it digitally over several days, but the artistic idea of the project is not yet complete with the printing. Individual art bottles from the "Chromatic Canvas I" series are also used as canvases and subsequently painted over with acrylic colours.

CONTEMPORARY Stagings

Mathias Enipriss

Impressively colourful, provocative, tongue-in-cheek, glamorous, opulent, shrill and at the same time intimate, are the works of photo artist and storyteller Mathias Kniepeiss. His artworks take the viewer on a journey through time and whisk them away to bizarre worlds. In his fantastically exaggerated photo series, he uses the means of photography to blur the boundaries between reality and appearance, capturing and recording life in all its sensuality.

He achieves this at locations that are true to the original, where he gathers a team of actors, make-up and costume designers and set designers around him to recreate a hyper-real setting in which every last detail has been perfectly researched and prepared after a long lead time. In his photo series, historical quotations are staged just as grandiose as visually stunning visions.

Mathias manages to create a unique tension in his productions and exude a dynamic that turns the viewer into a voyeur and gives him the feeling of being part of the events; of finding himself in the courtly rococo, in the Italian syndicate or discovering the facets of Venetian history.

The interplay of light and shadow, as well as movement and stillness, is perfect. His approach to colour and overall composition actually has a lot in common with painting - in the style of the old masters of art history. Instead of palette and brushes, he uses digital tools to create new, original images. Mathias skilfully plays with emotions, associations and stories.

Rococo

In 2013, this project was realised with a team of 6 people and 8 actors in the south of Austria. The preparation and planning of the series took 6 months. In one day, an original rococo castle was used to create 4 so-called one-shot stagings.

Rococo is a mixture of modern photography, live performance and digital painting. The interpretation presented is based on extensive research into the period, with the intention of reflecting our present in the past and the past in our present.

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Dirty 30's

The Dirty 30's series was planned for 4 months and realised with a team of 9 people and 8 actors in Vienna in 2015. Four one-shot stagings were created in one day in an original 1930s bar.

To achieve the intended effect of the works, we used the body language of our models, the overall composition of the group, colour psychologies, bespoke costumes, elaborate sets, real locations, detailed accessories and modern post-production processes.

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Faces of Venice

This series was not planned but realised spontaneously with a team of 10 people in Venice in 2017. Several productions were created on 3 different weekends full of spontaneous acting, good humour and a lot of craziness.

Faces of Venice is a mixture of modern photography, live performance in front of an audience and digital painting. We used the body language of our models, customised costumes, real locations, detailed accessories and digital post-production and digital post-production processes.

Through digital painting, I merge traditional craft techniques with innovative technologies to create an exciting artistic experience. Using pressure sensitive pens on state of the art graphics tablets opens up a new dimension of creative design for me.

The enormous variety of brush shapes and sizes offers me an almost infinite repertoire of expressive possibilities. Each brushstroke carries the nuances of my hand movement and the print, while the digital canvas always remains immaculate and flexible.

Working on different layers allows me to combine different styles and techniques with each other and superimpose layered properties to create complex and multi-layered works. These three-dimensional works of art are created not only through the illusionary depth of the digital representation, but also through the depth of my artistic vision, which is created through the fusion of old and new.

Digital painting allows me to push boundaries while preserving the essence of traditional art forms. It is a process of discovery and innovation where my imagination is fuelled by the infinite possibilities of the digital world.





gFoC geometric fields of colours

In this series I combine the fascinating worlds of geometry and colour, based on photographs of landscapes, industry and architecture. Countless layers of geometric signs combined with harmonising yet contrasting colours create a composition that speaks directly to our subconscious.

Geometric shapes influence us all, they surround and guide us. They are everywhere: in our cities, in our houses, on our streets, on every screen, in nature, in the human body, in the entire universe!

The perception of colours also affects our feelings and our mind. Colours are able to improve our mood, calm us down or stimulate us. They can also intensify negative feelings. Archetypes anchored in our subconscious influence our behaviour, our way of thinking and our feelings.





Based on travel, architectural and industrial photography, this series features countless layers of lines and shapes to create three-dimensional spaces and worlds that deal with the visualisation of our dreams.

Sigmund Freud, the inventor of psychoanalysis, saw dreams as an indication of the sleeper's hidden desires, which are suppressed when awake and then satisfied in dreams at night. Freud described dreams as the "royal road to the unconscious".

Carl Gustav Jung, the founder of analytical psychology, also attached great importance to dreams: He saw them as a level of communication between the conscious and the unconscious.

abstract reflections of creatures

Based on travel, architectural and industrial photography, I create abstract figures in this digital painting series figures that each viewer should recognise and interpret individually.

I deliberately play with the phenomenon of pareidolia. It's about recognising supposed faces and familiar beings or objects in things and patterns.

Our brain processes visual stimuli with their characteristics and puts together a coherent image from the light stimuli. However, the process of perception does not only include the reception and processing of stimuli. Rather, visual perception is also about recognising. Our brain determines what we see, how we see something and is influenced by implicit assumptions and individual experiences.

Vibrant Market






